# STUDY/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Jesus declared himself the light of the world in a culture that had waning confidence in "organized religion." What are some ways that our world has moved away from traditional religion?
- 2. Read John 7:37-39, followed by John 8:12. Jesus declares himself the source of the Holy Spirit and the source of light two elements necessary for sustaining life. In what ways does our culture today seek to have "life" without God? What have been the consequences?
- 3. Read John 8:31-44. How does the truth "set us free?" What are the consequences of failing to live in God's truth? How is sin a form of enslavement?
- 4. Read John 8:51-58. What provocative statement does Jesus make? How does our culture respond to the claim that Jesus is truly God?
- 5. Read John 9:1-7. What do the disciples initially assume about the man's blindness? According to Jesus, what is the reason for the man's blindness?
- 6. Read John 9:24-34. How might you summarize the man's testimony? How do the Jewish leaders respond?
- 7. Read John 9:35-41. How does Jesus bring lasting change to the man's life? According to Jesus, what is the true source of spiritual blindness?
