## STUDY/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Do you think that today's world is more self-centered than it was a generation ago? Explain.
- 2. Read John 13:1-11. Why would Jesus' actions have been so surprising to the disciples? Why was it significant for Jesus to humble himself in this manner?
- 3. Read John 13:12-20. Jesus says that he washed the disciples' feet as an example. What are some ways that Christians can fulfill this example?
- 4. Read John 13:21-30. Name some of the things that influenced Judas to betray Jesus. Why is it significant that Jesus washed his feet anyway?
- 5. Read John 13:31-38. What is the "new commandment?" How is it new?
- 6. What does Jesus say that Christians will be most known for? Do you think that's true of modern Christians today?
- 7. Who do you find the hardest to love? How can the gospel motivate you toward greater love or humility this week?

# QUESTION OF THE WEEK

- Do you think that humility is a positive trait?
- Do you believe that religious people are loving?
- [For your kids]: Who do you find difficult to love? How can the love of Jesus help us love others?

## STUDY/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What does "grief" look like to you? How does contemporary society handle the reality of death?
- 2. Read John 11:1-16. What surprises you about Jesus' reaction to his friend's illness? Why does Jesus say that he's "glad?"
- 3. Read John 11:17-27. What does Martha say to Jesus upon his arrival? What does it mean for Jesus to be the "resurrection and the life?"
- 4. Read John 11:28-37. What does Mary say to Jesus upon his arrival? How would you characterize Jesus' response to the ongoing funeral?
- 5. Read John 11:38-44. This is the first recorded prayer in John's gospel. Why does Jesus pray? What are the results?
- 6. Read John 12:1-8. How does Mary thank Jesus for saving her brother? What does this reveal about Jesus' true mission?
- 7. Read John 12:9-19. What do the people seem to be expecting from Jesus, the King? Read Zechariah 9:10-11. How will Jesus bring peace? What does this tell us about Jesus' true mission?

- Do you think our society is shielded from death?
- Why do you think people look for modern-day "saviors" in the political arena?
- [For your kids]: Describe what the best "king" would look like. How is Jesus the same or different from those expectations?
