- 5. Read John 15:18—16:4. What fate awaits the disciples? How does a relationship with Jesus prepare us for mission in a hostile world?
- 6. Read John 16:5-11. What are some of the roles of the Holy Spirit, according to this passage? How does the Holy Spirit act to magnify the name of Jesus?
- 7. What are some "habits" that you can practice to more faithfully "abide" in Christ?
